#### 6. COMPETITION FORMULA

The teams shall compete following the principle "one against each other" in one single round (Berger table).

**Allocation of points (CEV Volleyball Competition Regulations, Section 2, CEV competitions, Chapter 1, Article 3., 4.):**

2.2.1. For all the rounds of the EEVZA Championships, the standing of a Participant shall be as follows:

2.2.2 Standing is based on the number of matches won.

Points for won and lost matches are allocated as follows:

- Winner 3:0 or 3:1 3 points
- Winner 3:2 2 points
- Loser 2:3 1 point
- Loser 1:3 or 0:3 0 point

2.2.3. There is a tie between Teams when each team has the same number of matches won.

In case of tie, the standing of the Participants is established by using the following criteria in the following mentioned order, until the tie ends:

- In descending order by the number of allocated points for won and lost matches,
- In descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of all sets won by all sets lost during the competition,
- In descending order by the set points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by all sets points lost during the competition,

- In descending order by the result(s) of the match(es) played between them

2.2.4 Forfeit is imposed as foreseen in the Official Volleyball Rules, the FIVB Sports Regulations or CEV Official Regulations.

2.2.5 Any team refusing to play a match shall be sanctioned according to the CEV Code of Discipline. The results obtained up to the moment of its exclusion shall be cancelled.

2.2.6 A match will be accounted for as lost by 0-3 (0-25; 0-25; 0-25) by the team concerned:

◆ If a doping rule violation occurs

If one or more players are not eligible as per the provisions of these Regulations.

2.2.7 A team refusing to play against another team shall be excluded from the rest of the EEVZA AGE Championships. The results obtained up to the moment of its exclusion shall be cancelled. As of the time of exclusion, all further expenses incurred shall be borne by the defaulting team.

### 8. MEDICAL SERVICES AND CONTROL

All players are obliged to present a Health Certificate – M-4 Form – issued 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2016 or later. Each Team, participating in the competition, must present during the Preliminary Inquiry.

The organizer will provide first aid. All other medical services should be paid in accordance with the Rules of the Russian medical service.

Any Application for the **THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTION** must be sent confidentially to the FIVB no less than 30 days before the concerned match.

### 9. OFFICIAL VOLLEYBALL RULES AND BALLS

The competitions shall be played in accordance with the CEV Rules of the Game in force. The only Ball to be used for all matches is the MIKASA MVA-200.

### 10. UNIFORMS

The playing uniform must be in conformity with FIVB Rules of the Game. Each team must have available 2 sets of playing uniforms–Captain's set and Libero's set. Player names on the shirts must be printed.

Publicity on playing uniforms must be registered in accordance with the CEV Regulations.

### 11. EXPENSES

#### EXPENSES COVERED BY THE ORGANIZER

All transportation expenses from the airport Anapa or Krasnodar to the hotel and competition site and back, as well as all local transfers.

The hotel and food costs for 20 persons (14 players, 5 officials+ 1 referee) per team, for a total of 8 double rooms and 3 single rooms per team. Referees of the teams are accommodated in dbl rooms.

#### **EXPENSES COVERED BY THE PARTICIPATING DELEGATIONS**

Each team shall bear its own international traveling expenses to the international airport of arrival/departure.



Each team **must pay** a contribution fee to the food & lodging to the organizer for each of the member of its delegate on, amount to:

**300 EURO (i.e. 50, - EURO x 6 [six] days).**

The arrival and the departure day account together for 1 day.

A maximum of 3 (three) extra persons, in addition to the 20 official team members may accompany their respective delegations at their own expense (the names have to be communicated to the organizers, using the EEVZA-05 form). The *extra* persons are entitled to single rooms for the price of **100. - EUR** (the price includes all services provided to the official team members).

All hotel and food expenses incurred after 12h00 of the day following the last match played, All insurance not borne by the Organizers (as per CEV Regulations), shall be borne by participating teams.

**All telephone and mini-bar costs in the hotel (on the arrival day, the Team manager of each team must leave his credit card number at the reception desk for this purpose).**

## 12. PRELIMINARY INQUIRY

Preliminary Inquiry will be carried out by the organizers in VoleyGrad hall on the 22 November 2016 according to the time of the teams' arrival.
