#### 7. PRELIMINARY INQUIRY/TECHNICAL MEETING

**Preliminary inquiry** will be held on the arrival day depending on the teams' arrival time and will be defined and announced after 25 November 2015.

- EEVZA-M-4 (Valid Health certificate of each player);

### 9.1. Points scoring system.

UPDATED Ranking point counting system (EEVZA Competition Regulations Chapter 1, Art.4.7):

4.7.2.1 The positions of teams are determined by the total number of matches won.

4.7.2.2 In case of an equality in the number of matches won by two or several teams, these teams will be classified in descending order by the number of points awarded per match to each team:

- Winner 3:0 3 points
- Winner 3:1 2 points
- Loser 0:3 0 point
- Loser 1:3 1 points

4.7.2.3 If the tie persists, as per number of points, these teams will be classified in descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of the number of all sets won by the number of all sets lost.

4.7.2.4 If the tie persists, as per the set quotient, these teams will be classified in descending order by the set points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by the total of set points lost during all sets.

4.7.2.5 If the tie continues, as per the sets points quotient, these teams are placed according to the result(s) of the match(es), which the teams have disputed between themselves.

4.7.3 Forfeit is imposed as foreseen in the Official Volleyball Rules, the FIVB Sports Regulations or CEV Official Regulations.

4.7.4 Any team refusing to play a match shall be sanctioned according to Article 16.3.2 of the Code of Discipline.

The results obtained up to the moment of its exclusion shall be cancelled.

## 10. MEDICAL SERVICES AND CONTROL

All players are obliged to present a Health Certificate – issued **17 November** 2015 or later. Each Team representatives, participating in the competition must present during the Preliminary Inquiry.

The organizer will provide first aid. All other medical services should be paid in accordance with the Rules of the Polish medical service.

## 11. OFFICIAL VOLLEYBALL RULES AND BALLS

The competition shall be played in accordance with the FIVB Volleyball Rules of the Game in force. All necessary interpretations will be done before the competitions during the Technical Meeting.

The only Ball to be used for all matches is the MIKASA MVA -200.



## 12. FINANCIAL MATTERS

### EXPENSES COVERED BY THE ORGANIZER

- Transportation from the Gdansk Airport to the Hotel and back.
- All transportation expenses from the hotel and competition hall and back;
- The board and lodging costs for 18 persons (12 players, 5 officials + 1 referee) per team;
- Laundry of 12 sets of uniforms (1 pair of socks, 1 t-shirt and 1 pair of shorts) during match days;
- Medical care;
- Organizer will provide a cup and 17 gold medals for the EEVZA Champion and team's classified 2nd and 3rd will receive 17 medals per each team respectively silver and bronze. All prizes will be given during the closing ceremony.

### Each delegation shall bear the following costs:

- International transportation to the official venue of arrival and departure and back;
- Contribution to the board and lodging - 45 EURO per person per day x 4 days=180 EUR per person;
- The arrival and departure day is counting as 1 (one) full day;
- Board and lodging of the extra persons/days - 85 EURO per person per day.

For non-presenting the Referee with the delegation, concerned National Federation has sanctioned with penalty **250 EUR**, which has to be paid by concerned National Federation to Organizer.

The Volleyball Federation of Poland is ready, on the basis of a written application, to give each participating Federation corresponding support
