COMPETITION FORMAT	The Championship competitions method and final classification will be decided by EEVZA Office together with the Local Technical Supervisor and Hosting Federation, depending on the total amount of registered teams.			
NUMBER OF TEAMS	According to the General EEVZA Age (U18-U16) Beach Volleyball Championship Regulations each country for the competition can register maximum two teams per gender . In case some National Federations will not use their rights to register two teams per gender, the EEVZA Office and Organizing Federation has possibility to fiil the roster with the additional local and international teams from EEVZA countries.			
TEAM UNIFORMS	The organizer will not provide uniforms to the participating teams, and as a result the participating National Federations shall provide their players with minimum 2 sets of uniforms in different colors according to the layout specified in Annex 2 of the General EEVZA Age (U18-U16) Beach Volleyball Championship Regulations and may exploit them commercially (excluding the following product categories: alcohol (sprits), tobacco & pornography). Uniforms must be presented during the Preliminary Inquiry. National Federations/ Athletes are responsible to bring ther own shorts/ bikini bottoms as per provisions of the CEV Beach Volleyball Regulations. Athletes may use gear and accessories as defined in the CEV Beach Volleyball Guidelines.

SCHEDULE

Teams taking part in the Championship, mandatory have to attend the Preliminary Inquiry and Technical Meeting (optional, if organized). Players, who do not arrive or arrive late for the Preliminary Inquiry and have not received the authorization of the nominated Technical Supervisor, will be excluded from the event.

During the Preliminary Inquiry players' uniforms and Health Certificates (CEV/ FIVB or EEVZA) for players have to presented.

Respective proof/documentation, i.e. passports or official ID cards, issued by government bodies for players, official accreditations by IOC/ FIVB/ CEV for doctors, physiotherapists must be presented to the local organizer representative before the start of the Preliminary Inquiry of the respective event.

All meetings will be held on the venue.

CONTRIBUTION FEE

Entry/Contribution fee will be the same, as fixed in EEVZA AGE Championships Regulations, i.e. this "contribution fee" amounts 50,00 EURO x number of competition days per person. This amount must be paid by the invoice before the arrival to the bank account of orginising Federation (Lithuanian Volleyball Federation). The arrival and the departure days both are counting as 1 [ONE] full day. In case National federations are registering more than two teams, they are not obliged to pay above mentioned contribution fee, but responsible for all the expenses of these teams, including accommodation and meals. For other in a set deadline (article 6.) registered persons (i.e. assistant coaches, physiotherapists, doctors – no more than 4 persons) is determined same price (50,00 EUR) as per Official delegation.

In case still any additional extra persons, not mentioned before are requested by

	participating National Federations, it's determined by Organizer and has to be announced in Practical info, but this payment can't exceed more than 100 EUR per person per day. It's recommended for NF/Organizer to reduce price for extra persons more similar as Official delegation.	
ACCOMMODATION, LODGING, TRANSPORTATION	Accommodation will be arranged for the officially registered delegations and by the request of federations also for other members of official delegation. Local organizer one day before starting and one day ending of the competition will cover expenses of accommodation, lodging of official delegation, for other members, federations will pay by themselves. Information about amount of extra persons has to be sent to Organizer no later than 15 days before the starting of the competition.	
	Federation of participating teams is responsible for their international travel and visa costs as well. Each team must organize its own travel to the official venue of arrival/departure indicated by the organizer of the event. The Organizer shall provide local transport from the official venue of arrival and departure to the hotel and back for the Officials, referees, players, coaches and other official delegations members. The travel schedules of all teams have to be organized in such a way that they are present at the Preliminary Inquiry and Technical Meeting (if organized).	
	All delegations officially admitted to participate in this event from Organizer shall receive in due time an invitation letter for visa purposes.	
	The delegations will be accommodated in a 2 minutes walking distance from the venue "Raddisson Blu" (Konstitucijos pr. 20, Vilnius).	
	All meals will be provided in the Official hotel of "Radisson Blu".	
	The organizers will provide breakfast, lunch and dinner per day per official members of delegation (on the day of arrival not earlier as lunch, on the day of departure no later as lunch). The schedules for the meals will be arranged on the arrival dates together with the delegates.

EEVZA wants to ensure that all of its stakeholders have all of the necessary information related to COVID-19 and has taken steps to minimize the potential risk of COVID-19. However, the EEVZA notes that a risk of COVID-19 still exists despite all efforts.

With the information provided in the Practical Information documents, on EEVZA and National Authorities websites, we would like to inform you of the possible risks involved in this Tournament 2021 event that includes the travel to and from the event. You are participating in your own free will and you are aware of and assume the possible risks related to the COVID-19 by participating in this event.

To be specific, by acknowledging this document and continuing to participate in the event after receiving it as part of Practical Information document, you are aware and agree that:

- 1. While the local protocols and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk still does exist; accordingly, your participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases, including but not limited to COVID-19; and,
- 2. You knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the event and assume full responsibility for his/her participation in this event; and,
- 3. You willingly agree to comply with the EEVZA Competitions Hygiene Guidelines, the local protocols and requirements in place in and outside the venue (imposed by National Federations Government for events organizing). If, however, you observe any unusual or significant hazards during the player presence or participation, you may remove yourself from the event and participation; and,
- 4. You, hereby release and hold harmless the EEVZA and the event organizers and organizing National Federation, including officials, delegates, sponsors, staff, volunteers

and other players with respect to any and all illness, disability or loss/damage to the player's person or property, whether arising from the negligence of the releases or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

5. Organizer of the event will cover all medical & accommodation expenses if diagnosed with Covid-19 infection on site.

We kindly ask that you reflect on the above and take the time to seriously consider the implications of the above on you and your families before taking a decision as to whether you wish to participate.

If you agree with the above points, you are kindly required to duly sign this document. If you do not agree on the conditions and you are not signing the agreement, this will result in your immediate withdrawal from the event.
